Weather Preparedness Plan

The On Top of the World Community has an emergency preparedness plan in place that addresses community wide safety concerns during tropical storm weather. In the event of severe weather conditions Parkway Maintenance & Management and SCA Facilities may suspend normal operations, including suspending laundry and elevator operations. Updated information may be obtained from www.otowclearwaterinfo.com; OTOW Alerts (RAVE); on Channel 732 and at each Activity Center.

For community emergencies please call 727-799-1115.

(Personnel are on call however they will not be dispatched if winds exceed 35 mph or county wide flooding is occurring)

As with any weather related event all residents should be prepared for possible power outages.

As a reminder, the Activity Centers are not designated as storm shelters.

These facilities would be closed.

We urge residents to follow Pinellas County Emergency Bulletins and take emergency precautions as advised.

• Important Reminders:

- Do **NOT** drive or walk through standing water, past barricades or road closed signs.
- Stay inside during storms or storm warnings. Do not jeopardize your safety or the safety of emergency responders.

The emergency gate on Netherlands Drive is open for those residents residing in the northeast section of the community. Detour signs are in place. Alternate vehicle parking would be available at the golf course and East Activity Center.
